## **WUKF competition Rules apply with slight modifications by the Chief Referee**

### **RULES OF KATA**

- Kata will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd place only.
- Individuals up to and including 4th Kyu may repeat the same Kata in each round.
- Individuals 3rd Kyu and above must perform a different kata each round.
- Teams may repeat the same kata in each round.
- All categories will be over 3 rounds with 12 going through to the 2nd round and 6 going through to the 3rd round (Finals)
- The scores from the 2nd round will be added to the final round scores.
- Competitors must wear their grade belt when performing Kata.
- Discrete hair clips or bobbles, no metallic hair clips, hair bands or jewellery.
- The Gi must be all white, the trousers and jacket must fit properly as to the WUKF rules.

### **RULES OF KUMITE**

- Gum shields (properly fitted).
- Juniors will fight for 1.5 minutes Shobu nihon, Seniors 2 minutes Shobu sanbon (subject time)
- Mitts red for Aka/white or blue for Shiro (soft cloth type are not allowed)
- Belts red for Aka/white for Shiro.
- Chest protectors 15yrs plus for female kumite (compulsory).
- Groin protectors 15yrs plus for male Kumite (compulsory).
- Chest protectors and Groin protectors under 15yrs is advisable.
- Head guards and body armour for under 15yrs are optional.
- Soft shin pads are allowed. (Combined shin and instep forbidden).
- Glasses are forbidden. Soft contact lenses may be worn at competitors own risk.
- Bandages, padding or supports because of injury must be approved by the Official Medical Representative.
- All jewellery must be removed; Fingernails and toenails must be short.
- The wearing of metallic teeth braces must be approved by the Chief Referee and Official Medical Representative. If accepted, then the coach must accept full responsibility should the user be injured.
- Please note that in kumite events there may be a difference in height and weight between competitors.
- All events will be taken through to the finals and the awards will take place on the Tatami.
- All kumite events will be for 1st, 2nd and joint 3rd place.
- The Gi must be all white, the trousers and jacket must fit properly as to the WUKF rules.

### **FORBIDDEN TECHNIQUES**

#### **14yrs under**

- No contact to the face, head or head guard.
- No leg sweeps.
- No holding, grabbing or throwing.
- No open hand techniques to the face.
- No attacks to the hips, knee, instep, or direct attacks to the arms and legs.
- No excessive contact to the body, uncontrollable techniques or feigning injury.
- Contact to the throat or groin will be warned (even if accidental)

#### **15yrs Plus**

- No excessive contact to the head, face or neck.
- No Open hand techniques to the face.
- No attacks to the hips, knee, instep or direct attacks to the arms and legs.
- Contact to the groin or throat will be warned or penalised (even if accidental).
- Controlled but decisive techniques to the body.
- Legs sweeps or grabbing not followed immediately by a technique or an attempt at a takedown will be warned or penalised.
- All take downs must be controlled.

## COACHES

- Coaches must wear a track suit (preferably their association) when entering the Tatami area.
- The association coach will only be allowed in the Tatami area when their competitor is fighting or performing kata.
- Competitors who fail to report to an area at the start of their event will be disqualified.
- Any competitor, coach or representative who behaves discourteously to any member of the refereeing panel may cause the immediate disqualification of their competitor and or the whole delegation.
- The named coach is responsible for the behavior of all his/her competitors and any spectator accompanying their competitors.
- S/he is responsible for obtaining parental or guardian permission for entry into the event and checking that their competitors have
- Appropriate insurance, through their respective associations.
- The association coach is the only representative who will be permitted to raise an objection or discuss possible infringements with the officials.
- Coaches must be absolutely certain that their competitors are entered into the correct category; it may not be possible to change entries on the day.
- Coaches should inform their competitors to register their name at the table if they get through to the next round, this helps save administration mistakes.
